RE: Harmonized System Commodity Code (HS Code) Requirement

Dear MOL Customer,

Please be advised that effective October 12, 2015, MOL Liner will ask all customers to provide a 6-digit Harmonized System Commodity Code (HS Code) at the time of submitting the Shipping Instruction (SI) for all shipment origin. The provision of the HS code is optional, the SI process will still be proceeded if the code is not provided, except in cases where the customs requested.

HS Code is a valuable supplement to the general cargo descriptions. The provision of the HS Code together with accurate commodity descriptions provided by customers will make the documentation process more efficient and help us to deliver a better customer experience to you.

As a valuable customer, we appreciate your full support and cooperation for the provision of HS Code in SI.

The HS code is an internationally standardized system of names and numbers for classifying traded products developed and maintained by the World Customs Organization (WCO). For your convenience, the HS Code list will be posted on our website (<http://cms.molpower.com/announcementdetail?id=535>).
