Please be advised that MOL will implement a General Rate Increase (GRI) for **all Asia* to U.S. Import cargo** effective March 17, 2014 as follows:

40-foot High-Cube Containers	US\$450
45-foot High-Cube Containers	US\$505

Asia* to U.S. Import GRI	
<u>For cargo destined to U.S. East Coast ports/Miami, FL via USEC/Miami, FL and to inland locations in U.S. via USEC and/or Miami, FL (RIPI):</u>	GRI Effective March 17, 2014
20-foot Standard Containers	US\$320
40-foot Standard Containers	US\$400
40-foot High-Cube Containers	US\$450
45-foot High-Cube Containers	US\$505

**Per MOL's tariff, Asia also includes West Asia, East Africa, the Middle East, the Indian Subcontinent, and Oceania.*

This GRI will continue to apply on and after March 17, 2014 until the post-GRI rates have been posted to each individual service contract in effect.
